

Rain Gauge with Weather Person

Craft Materials

- 1.25L Bottle with top cut off or large clear container
- Wooden spoon
- Plastic bags
- Buttons
- Markers
- Tape
- Scissors
- Coloured card
- Wool
- Sticks
- Paddle pops
- String

Craft Steps

Follow the below steps to make your Rain Gauge. Or you can work along with us on the Craft Video!



1. Start with a wooden spoon and a stick. Attach the stick using tape towards the top of the wooden spoon to create arms for your weather person.
2. Make a rain poncho by cutting a square section of plastic bag. Fold it in half and cut a small section out of the middle of the folded edge.
3. Open this up to make sure the hole you have cut is the right size. Then slip it over the top of the spoon.
4. Tape the edges of the bag together to help secure it.
5. Add a plastic scarf by cutting the handle section of a plastic bag and tying it around the neck of your weather person.
6. Make some eyes for your weather person by sticking buttons onto the spoon end of your wooden spoon.



7. Cut out a nose from some coloured card and glue on or add a button.
8. Add a mouth by cutting a shape out of some coloured card and gluing on.
9. Add some hair. Cut some sections of wool, tape them together, and then tape to the top of the head.
10. Create a rain hat. Cut a rectangle out of your piece of plastic bag. This should be wider than the end of your weather person's head. Fold it in half and tape the edges. Place on to your weather person's head.
11. Make some marks along the stem of the spoon with a marker or wrap some tape around. This is so that when you sit it in the container you have marks to check the level of the rain.
12. Place the marked end into your bottle or clear container.

Now hope for some rain!
