

Pirate Hat, Patch and Hook



Craft Materials

- Large piece of paper or card approx. A2
- Cotton balls
- Cotton Buds
- Black card
- Stickers
- Elastic
- Foil
- Small plastic pot with slits in the bottom.
- Scissors
- Hole punch
- Glue
- Tape




Craft Steps

Follow the below steps to make your Pirate Set. Or you can work along with us on the Craft Video!



Pirate Hat

1. Fold the large piece of paper in half. Then fold it in half again but reopen this fold. This fold is to create a guideline.
2. From the folded edge fold the top corners in to meet the centre line. Creating triangles. You want to leave the unfolded edge open.
3. Fold the bottom edge (uppermost layer only) up creasing from the base of the triangles.
4. Turn the hat over and repeat step 3. Stick the edges together using tape.
5. Now check that the hat opens and fits on your head.
6. Add a skull and cross bones to the front of your pirate hat. Stick 2 cotton buds in a cross onto the hat.
7. Now stick on a couple of cotton balls as the skull, they should be squished together.



8. Add on 2 stickers as eyes.
9. Cut some little sections of black paper and stick them on to make the gaps in the teeth of the skull.

Eye Patch

10. Draw and cut out a half circle to make an eye patch.
11. Punch a hole in either upper corner of the eye patch.
12. Thread a length of elastic through the holes. Check how long it needs to be to fit around your head, then tie a knot at the appropriate length.

Hook

13. Roll then tightly pack up some large sections of foil into a long skinny roll.
14. Bend 1 end around to form a hook shape.
15. Thread the unbent end of the foil into a hole in a plastic pot. You have your pirate hook.

Now walk the plank!
