

Little Red Riding Hood




Craft Materials

- 2 rectangle pieces of red cardboard
- Other coloured card
- White card
- Brown crepe paper
- Brown string
- Brown wool
- Brown markers
- Scissors
- Tape
- Glue



Craft Steps

Follow the below steps to make your Little Red Riding Hood doll. Or you can work along with us on the Craft Video!



1. Let's start by making Little Red Riding Hoods dress and body. Using one piece of red card, mark two spots that will become the finger holes. Use a piece of plasticine and a pencil to punch two holes where you need to cut out.
2. Around the two holes draw two circles a bit wider than your fingers. Cut out the two circles.
3. Take some coloured card and use the base of your glue bottle or (or anoth round object) to trace a circle. Cut out the circle. This will make her head and face.
4. With the other piece of red card, draw and cut out a semi circle or rounded triangle shape. This will be her red hood. Glue the hood to the back of the head.
5. Cut some eye shapes out of the white card and glue them to the head. Draw on the pupils, a nose and a mouth.
6. If you like, you can make some hair out of crepe paper, string, and wool. Stick on to either side of the head to look like plaits.



7. Take the top two corners of the red rectangle card with the holes in it and fold them in to make a cone shape. Secure with tape. This will be her body.
8. Glue the head onto the top narrow part of the body.
9. Take a patty pan and punch two holes into either side of it. Poke each end of a pipe cleaner through the holes and secure them to make the handle shape. This will be her basket.
10. Tape the basket to her body. Now you can slide you pointer finger and middle finger through the two holes at the front to give your Little Red Riding Hood arms.

Watch out for the Big Bad Wolf!
