

Buried Bone with Brush

Craft Materials

- Egg carton
- Toilet rolls
- Kraft Paper/ newspaper/ baking paper/ paper bags
- Brown crepe paper/tissue paper/ paper
- Ice block stick / sticks
- Coloured paper
- Scissors
- Masking Tape



Craft Steps

Follow the below steps to make your Buried Bone. Or you can work along with us on the Craft Video!



1. Begin with a toilet roll and some paper bags. Start with scrunching up the paper bags.
2. Attach two crumpled up paper bags balls onto each end of the toilet roll to form the bone. Secure these with tape.
3. Wrap masking tape over most of the bone to help make it bone coloured and make sure that it is all connected well.
4. Cut the bottom off an egg carton, you only need the top section.
5. Cut up lots of small pieces of tissue paper, crepe paper, paper bag and put these in the egg carton. This will be your dirt.



6. Using a coloured piece of paper, cut a small rectangle section. Fold this section in half and cut lots of small slits into the paper. Don't cut all the way through, they need to stay together to form the brush bristles.
7. Tape the section of paper to the stick or paddle pop stick to give the brush a handle.
8. Place the bone in the egg carton and cover it with your paper dirt. Now you are all ready to discover an ancient bone!
