

Polar Bear

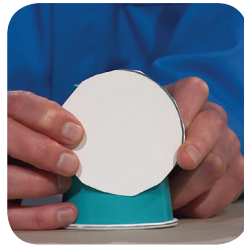
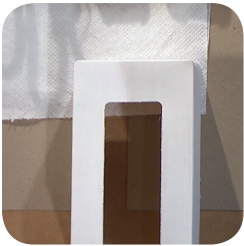
Craft Materials

- Tissue box
- White paint
- Tissues
- Paper towel or white serviettes
- Paper plate
- Black paper or stickers
- Paper cup
- Marker
- Cotton balls
- Tape
- Scissors

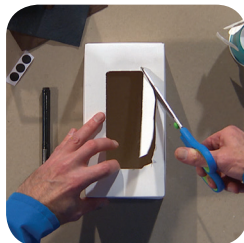


Craft Steps

Follow the below steps to make your Polar Bear. Or you can work along with us on the Craft Video!



1. Start by cutting out the entire bottom of the tissue box. Paint the tissue box white and set it aside to dry.
2. To make the polar bear, take the paper plate and paper cup. In the middle of the paper plate, trace around the top of the paper cup with a marker.
3. Cut out the circle, this will be the head of your polar bear.
4. Stick some black eyes and a nose onto your polar bear. Draw on a mouth.
5. With the leftover paper plate, cut out two round ear shapes and two oval arms shapes. Stick the ears to the back of the polar bear head.
6. Stick the polar bear head to the bottom of the paper cup and stick one arm to either side of the paper cup.



7. To make an icy tissue box fishing hole, make the hole at the top of the tissue box a bit bigger but cutting some away.
8. Take some paper towel and fold it into triangles. Tape two to the back of the tissue box.
9. Cover the rest of the tissue box with cotton balls and scrunched up tissues.
10. Now your Polar Bear has a little iceberg and fishing hole.
