

# Cowboy




## Craft Materials

- Cardboard
- Pegs
- Wool
- Coloured card
- Tape
- Scissors
- Markers




## Craft Steps

Follow the below steps to make your Cowboy. Or you can work along with us on the Craft Video!



1. Let's start by making a horse. Draw a horse body and head onto a sheet of cardboard. This could be made up of three ovals and a triangle. A big wide oval for the body, a long thin oval for the neck, a small wide oval for the head and a small triangle on top of the head. We don't want to draw any legs.
2. Use some scissors to cut out the horse body.
3. Cut some pieces of wool to make a mane for your horse. Stick these on with glue or tape.
4. Use the same wool to cut some pieces to make a tail for your horse. Stick these on with glue or tape.
5. Cut an oval shape out of a piece of coloured card and tape it over the middle of your horse body. This will be the saddle for your cowboy. Attach two pegs onto the horse body where the legs should be.



6. Take a third peg to make a cowboy. Draw on a face and colour in sections to give him clothes and boots.
7. Make a tiny cowboy hat by cutting an oval or circle shape out of brown card. Fold it in half then cut two holes out of the middle section. These need to be the same distance apart as the two points at the top of the cowboy peg.
8. Place the hat on your cowboy by slipping the cut out holes over the top of the peg.
9. Now you can peg your cowboy onto the saddle.
10. Don't forget to give your horse a nice happy face! You can draw this on with a marker or crayon.
